Mobile technology has at last caught up with Microsoft Outlook and Exchange. If you need to keep an eye on your email, have immediate up to date access to your calendar and contacts wherever you are with all the features of a mobile phone, this device is for you. The new HP IPAQ is a PDA device but with one major difference, it now connects to your exchange server automatically from anywhere covered by your mobile phone network. It also has all the facilities of a modern camera phone including Bluetooth, speaker phone, customisable ring tones, picture pop ups of your callers and a good camera which can be used to email photos but its major business function is as a mobile extension to your Outlook email, contacts and calendars.

So what does this mean in practice?

1. Wherever you are you simply hit the power button, press the messaging button and you will instantly see if you have any new emails. There is a large screen to read them properly, and a keyboard on which it is practical to type a reply, which will be sent immediately, and sit in your sent items as a permanent record just as if you were at your PC.
2. You can use it to check your diary and make appointments. If you're using it to book work appointments then your office will see the updates in the calendar immediately so there is no chance of being double booked. Likewise if someone in the office has made an entry to your diary you will see it on your HP IPAQ almost immediately.
3. Should you need contact details, as long as the info is stored in your Outlook system, you will have access to it from anywhere. You can also add contacts immediately instead of waiting to get back to the office. Once the contact details are added it will be synchronised with your exchange server.

The device has almost total redundancy, so if it is lost or broken data entered minutes before will have transferred to your exchange server in the office. A new IPAQ can then sync with it and all of your data will be restored. There is also a built in GPS receiver with quick locate function too. The device can even connect to the internet using your mobile phone contract or via a wireless network access point, making free browsing and free voice calls possible with the use of software like Skype. The new HP IPAQ is truly a revolution in mobile office technology!
